

# Name of the Scholarship Program

Evoking Potential Initiative Scholarship

#### Number of Scholarships to be Distributed

One scholarship per enrollment period for the Introduction to Intraoperative Neurophysiologic Program, for a total, of up to four scholarship awards annually.

# **Amount or Range of Each Scholarship**

\$15,350\* (Full program) 18 weeks

#### **Period of Time Covered**

The scholarship award covers the following time period allotted for the student to complete the Introduction to Intraoperative Neurophysiologic Monitoring program.

#### **Academic and Award Criteria**

The candidate must meet the admissions requirements for eligibility already set forth by the Center for Electroneurodiagnostics (CEN) and be accepted into the program to receive the scholarship award.

The Candidate must also meet the scholarship requirements and submit an application to the review committee.

#### Student Eligibility and Student Application Criteria

To be eligible for the Evoking Potential Initiative scholarship, the applicant must meet the current requirements for CEN and demonstrate need by providing the following information:

- Verification of minority status
- Financial need:
  - Personal Tax Return for the immediately prior year and most recent paystubs
    AND/OR Proof of financial aid for undergraduate and/or graduate degree.

### Statement indicating:

- Current desire for IONM training
- How the scholarship will enable them to overcome barriers to training
- Information about their current community service and leadership
- How they plan to use this to benefit communities and co-elevate

#### **Source of Scholarship Funds**

Scholarship funding is being provided by Center for Electroneurodiagnostics.

# Manner in Which Scholarships are Awarded/Paid to Students

Scholarships will be recorded on the student's account at the Center for Electroneurodiagnostics and the student's ledger card. The amount of the scholarship will also be reflected on the Enrollment Agreement under the payment type.

# **Provisions for Awarding Scholarships to Alternate Candidates**

Scholarships will be awarded to a qualified alternate candidate if:the original recipient decides that he/she does not wish to attend the CEN program.

#### Standards for Continued Scholarship Eligibility

The Evoked Potential Initiative Scholarship is a one-time award that is applied to the student's account upon enrollment. The student is responsible for meeting academic progress requirements and abiding by the Students Code of Conduct while receiving the scholarship.
